With no government funding for rough sleepers on the Peninsula, we are grateful for every type of support we receive. Last November, the Rotary Club of Sorrento held their Point Nepean Heritage Motor Show, nominating SPCS as the recipient of funds raised on the day. By end of the day, the Club had raised a whopping \$18,000 to go towards our SPLaSh program! That's special, with over \$120k in food and material given out through the program during the year these funds go a long way to guaranteeing the quality and continuity of what we provide. We know how much hard work goes into making an event like this a success, so we are incredibly grateful to everyone who volunteered their time to make it happen.
